WINE BY THE GLASS

Chateau Minuty Rosé, Côtes de Provence, FR \$12 \$47

Wine Spectator - 89 Points

Minerally, with heather and dried herb notes underpinning the white cherry and melon flavors of this elegant rosé.

Pariente, Rueda, Spain \$11.50 \$44

Very nice fresh and aromatic verdejo, pale yellow with nice bouquet of peach citrus honeysuckle and very nice acidity.

Cavaliere d'Oro Pinot Grigio Valdadige, Italy \$10 \$37

This Pinot Grigio benefits from the microclimate of the particular Valdadige area that gives the wine a straw-yellow color and an impressive fruity bouquet.

Willamette Valley Pinot Gris, Oregon \$11 \$42

Bright, light and lively: a wonderful white wine that pairs well with all seafood and chicken dishes.

Whitehaven Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand \$9.50 \$36

A fresh, juicy wine with vibrant acidity and plenty of weight and length on the palate.

Luminus Chardonnay Napa Valley \$12 \$47

Wine Spectator - 91 Points

Rich and plush, this has plenty of buttery notes to the ripe apple, pear and dried ginger flavors. Creamy finish.

Stags' Leap Chardonnay Napa Valley \$14 \$53

The fragrant citrus blossom bouquet opens with aromas of delicate Meyer lemon and lime zest.

Toscana, Super Tuscan, Tuscany, Italy \$9 \$34

Toscana this amazing Tuscan blend offers a balanced bouquet of wild berries and violet. This is a delightful ruby red wine.

Chateau St. Jean Pinot Noir, California \$9.50 \$35

This is a beautiful and classic Pinot Noir full of vivid aromas of ripe cherry and strawberry with subtle hints of baking spice.

Skyfall Merlot, Washington State \$11 \$41

Wonderfully developed plum, vanilla and leather aromas swirl in the glass.

Liberty School Cabernet, Paso Robles \$11 \$41

Cabernet Sauvignon opens with aromas of black cherry, plum and violets, followed by subtle flavors of strawberry and allspice.

Joel Gott 815 Cabernet, California \$12 \$47

Aromas of bright red fruit, black cherry and raspberry with notes of vanilla and white pepper. The wine opens with dark, concentrated fruit flavors.
